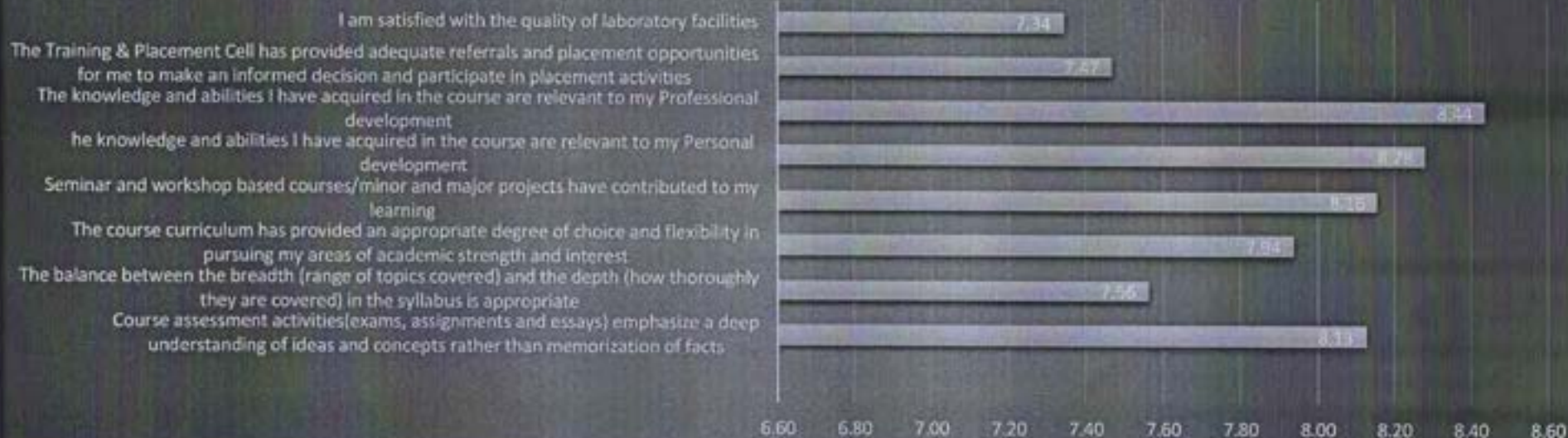

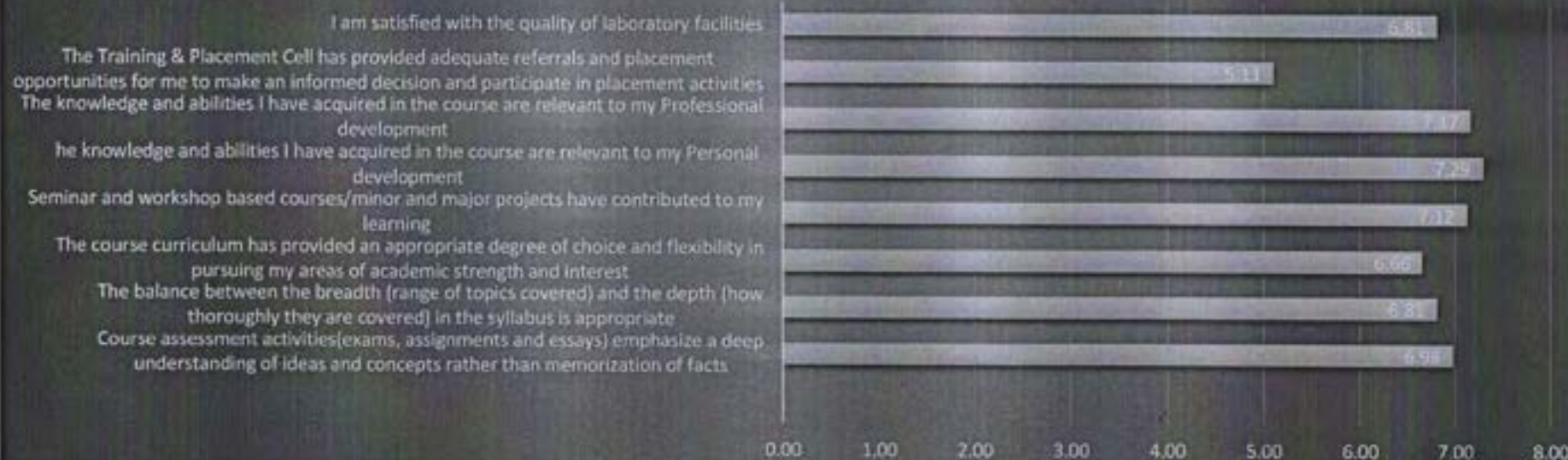

Student Feedback Rating (2014-2015)



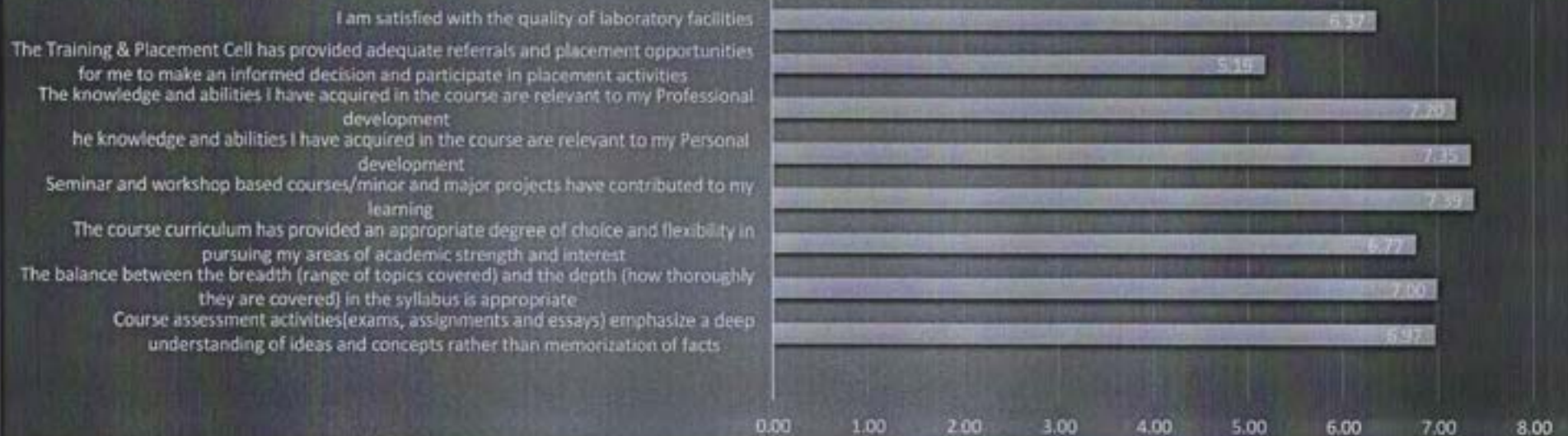
Student Feedback Rating (2015-2016)



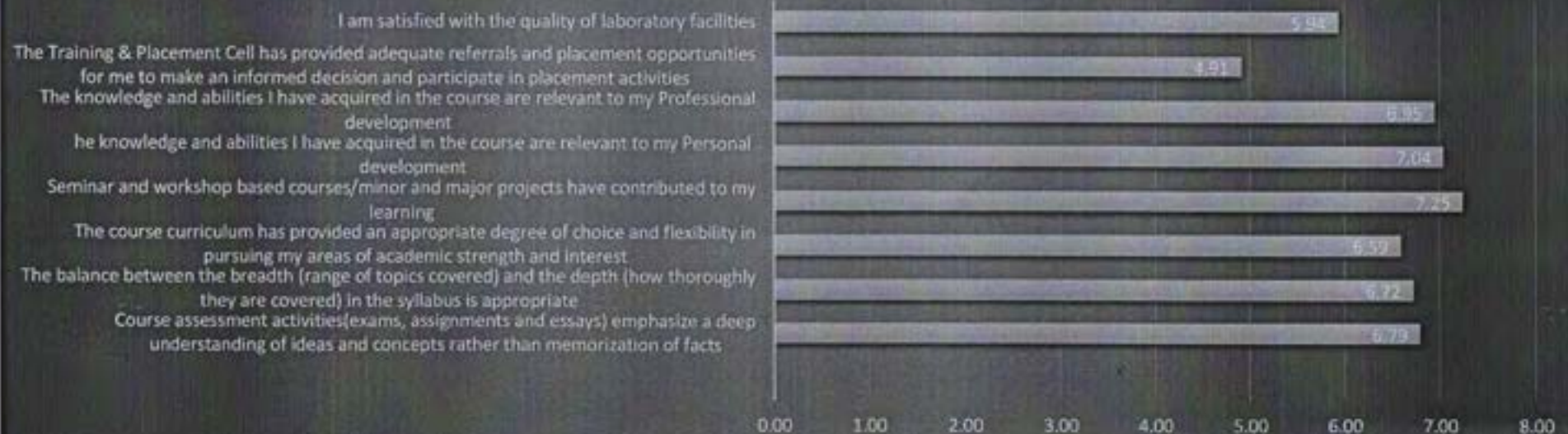

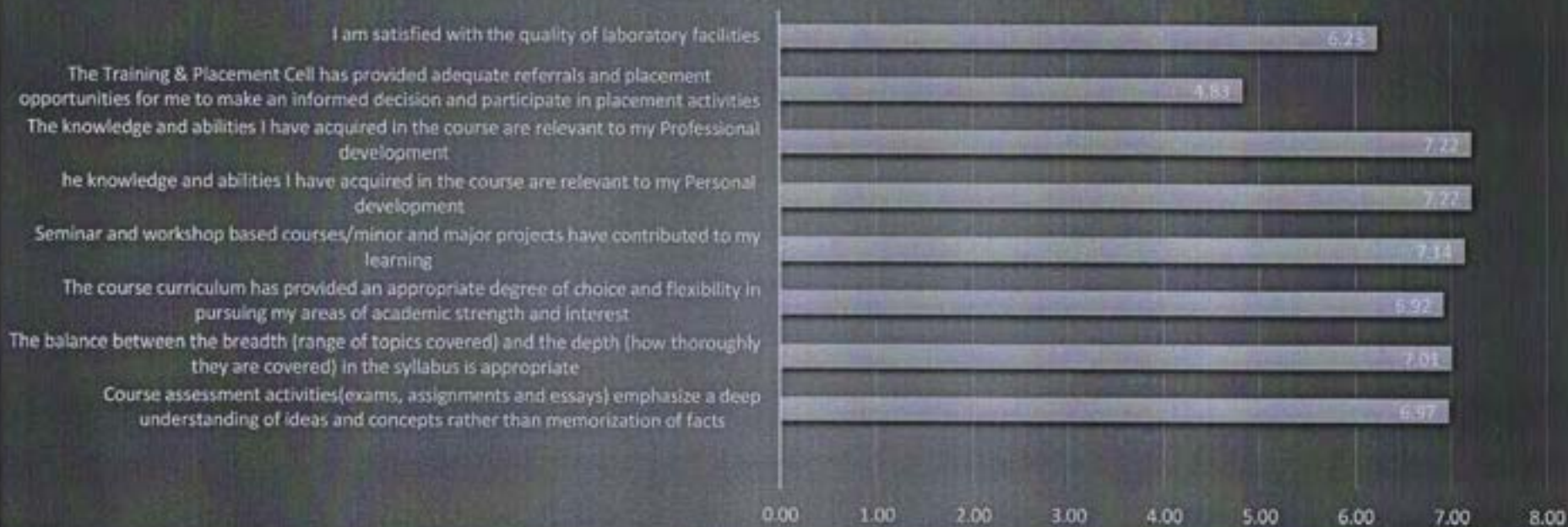

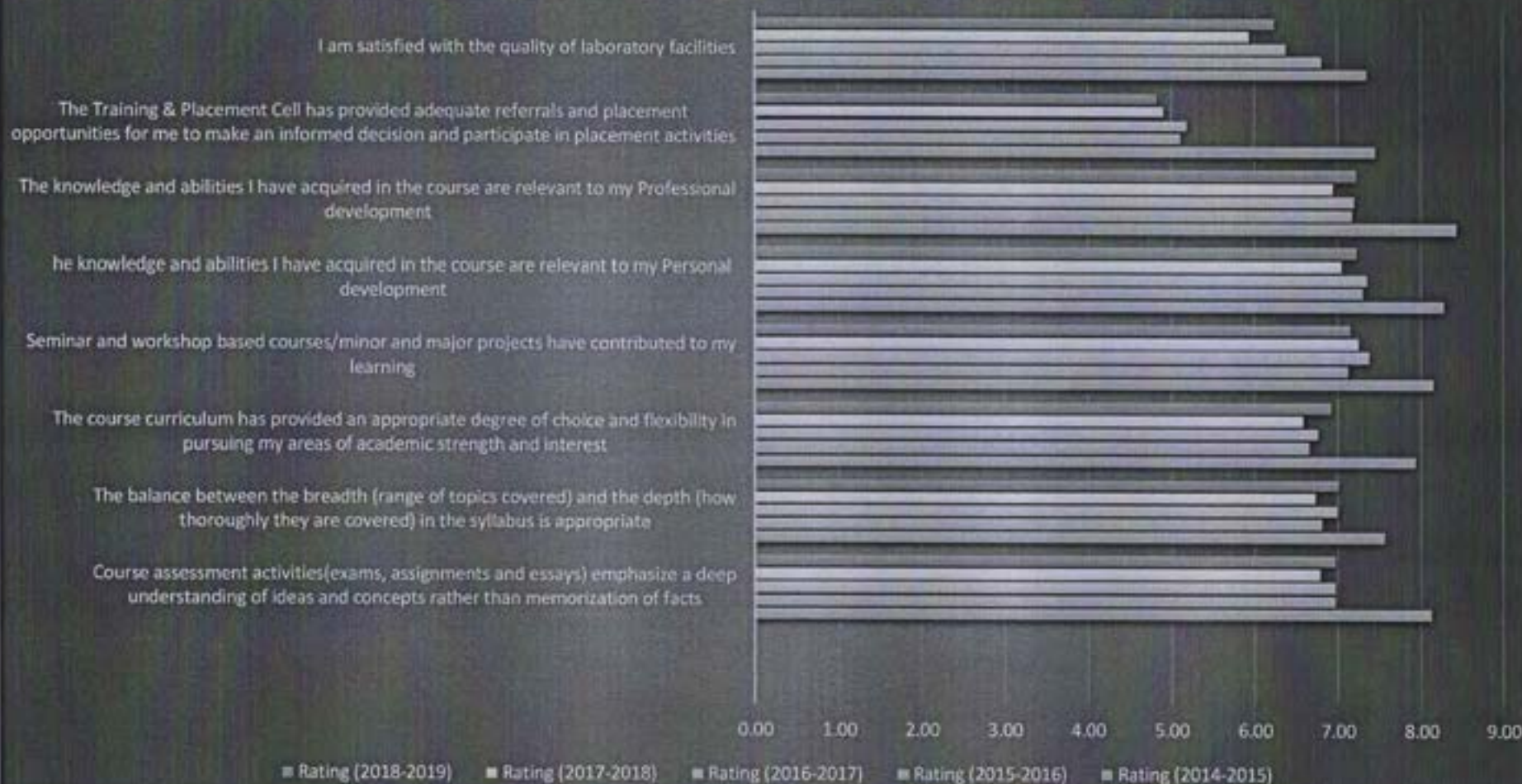

Actions Taken on Analysis of Student Feedback on design and review of syllabus

Based on analysis of student feedback and the vision of the university, the following programmes were conducted:

1. FDP on Developing as an Online Practitioner
2. FDP on Developing a Growth Mindset... for navigating change.
3. FDP on Towards Outcome based Teaching Learning Approach.
4. Refresher Course conducted for final year students by Dept. of CSE
5. Mock interviews conducted by each department
6. Aptitude tests coverings arithmetic, logical reasoning and verbal ability - Placement Papers, Banking Questions and others covered (dedicated in house software application)
7. Mock personal interview on departmental level covering industry technical questions and HR question
8. Group discussion sessions focusing on communication skills, general awareness and extempore skills. Practice sessions of GD have been initiated this time on selected Saturdays as well.
